ENROLLMENT

CORE COURSES

Students who enroll in an Oak Meadow course receive curriculum materials in the form of an Oak Meadow course book or syllabus, textbooks, and books, as well as ongoing teacher support and full academic credit.

Tuition: **\$2,000** per course per 10-month school year
 \$1,200 per course per 5-month semester

Discounts

Enrolled families are eligible to receive a 5% tuition discount for each additional sibling enrollment. Excluded from sale prices.

Active military service members and veterans are eligible for a 10% discount on all bookstore purchases and enrollment tuition. Active service members may provide a current pay stub (with all financial information blacked out) and contact information for a commanding officer, and veterans may submit form DD214 as proof of military status. This military discount cannot be used in combination with sales or other discounts.

Materials Credit

If you have the required textbook for a core course, we will apply a \$50 credit per course to the total tuition. No credit is given for an Oak Meadow course book or syllabus.

AP & TECH COURSES

TUITION PAYMENT PLAN

Please note: the Tuition Payment Plan has a \$900 minimum. CTYOnline courses are not eligible for the payment plan.

SHIPPING INFORMATION

CURRICULUM RETURNS & REFUNDS

When your curriculum arrives, plan to set aside time to look through everything carefully. Make sure that your order is complete and accurate, that the curriculum is what you expected, and that you feel confident it will work well for you and your children. **You have a 30-day evaluation period** after your curriculum arrives to examine it carefully and determine if it is the right fit for you and your children. If you have any concerns during this period, call or email us so we can answer your questions or discuss the options available to you.

If you decide during this 30-day period that you wish to return any of your course materials, we'll give you a full refund of your purchase price if the materials are in like-new condition. We do not refund shipping and handling charges. To return your curriculum, you must obtain a Return Merchandise Authorization number (RMA) from the office (call or email us). We must receive your curriculum within two weeks of issuing this number. Delaying the return of your materials will jeopardize your refund. Detailed instructions regarding how to package and ship your returned materials will be provided to you with your RMA number.

ENROLLMENT WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Many new families find distance education a unique approach to learning. We want to provide sufficient time for you to explore this method and be sure it is a good fit for your family. To facilitate this, **you are expected to begin the Oak Meadow program on your start date, completing 1 lesson per week and submitting 2 lessons to your teacher after 2 weeks.** This will provide time for your Oak Meadow teacher to engage with you and your child, review the work, and provide feedback. **We offer a 60-day evaluation period from your start date to evaluate the distance learning experience.**

During this period, if you feel that it would be best for you to pursue another educational approach, please call the office and speak to one of our Educational Counselors. The Educational Counselor will work with you to discuss your options, which may include a change in grade level, teacher re-assignment, withdrawal from the school and homeschooling with the curriculum, or withdrawing from the school and returning the curriculum. Should you decide that withdrawal is the best option, please send a written notification of withdrawal to registrar@oakmeadow.com. Refunds of tuition will be made as follows:

Those who withdraw in writing within the 60-day evaluation period will be eligible for a full refund or credit, less a 20% administrative processing fee.

For all materials retained (or returned in less-than-new condition), the price of the materials will be deducted from the eligible refund.

Refunds will be issued within 30 days of the written withdrawal.
